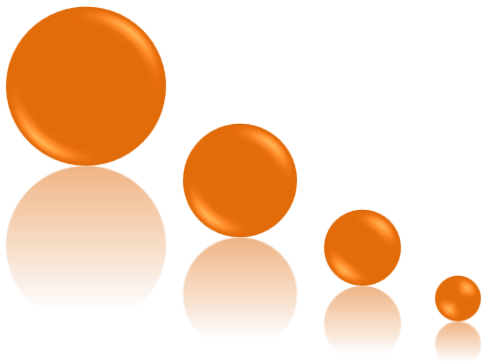

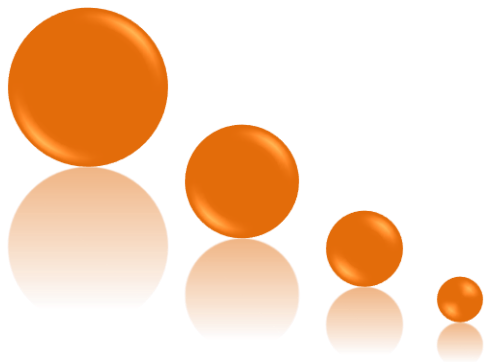

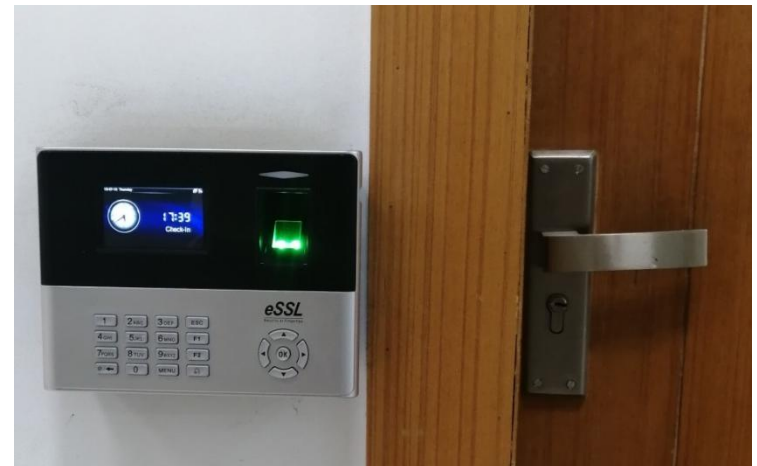

Expectations from students

On Campus in general

IMPORTANT DO'S & DON'TS

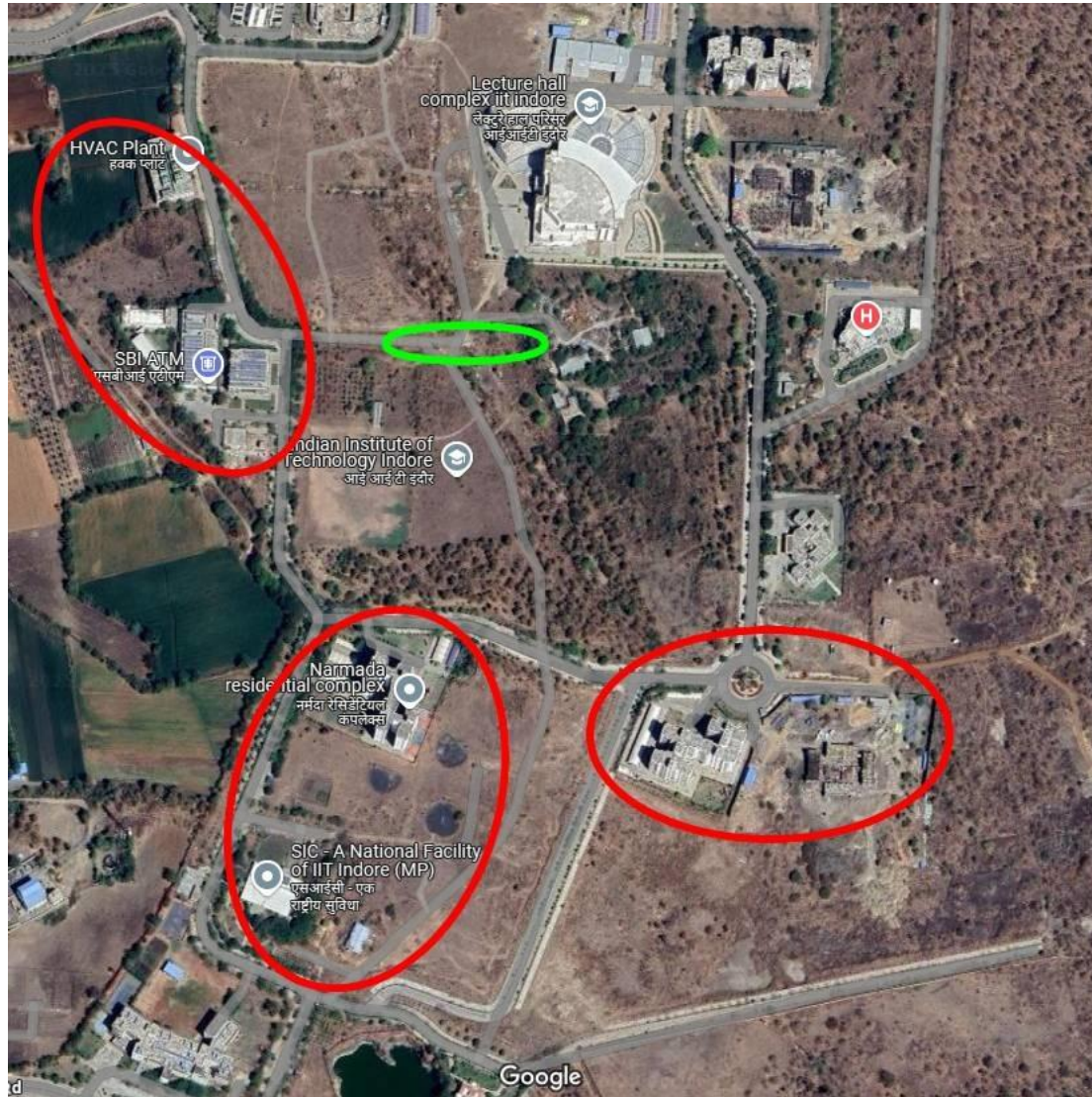
- ▶ Lock your room every time you leave.
- ▶ Do not keep huge amount of cash, campus is cashless.
- ▶ Do not keep expensive items like jewelry.
- ▶ Do not leave your petty stuff like umbrella, water bottle unattended
 - ▶ Do remember to mark your items for identification.
- ▶ Lock your bicycle after every use with good quality of lock, park your bicycle properly.
 - ▶ Facility of registration of bicycle is available with security team – CCTV Control room



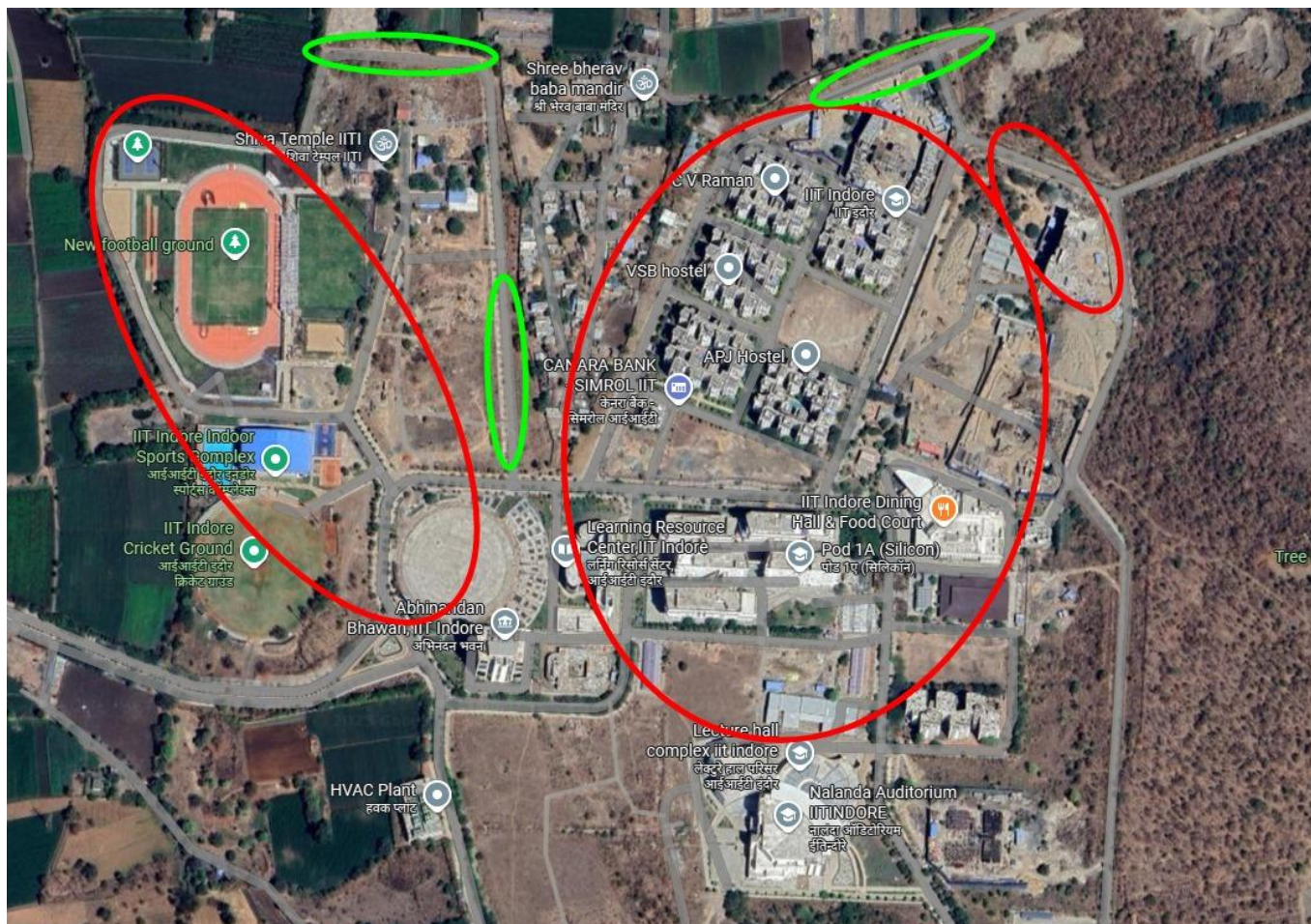
IMPORTANT DO'S & DON'TS

- ▶ Do not drive bicycle in corridors of hostels, academic pods.
- ▶ Do not take items like bicycles of others without their knowledge/consent.
- ▶ Do not use any powered vehicle on campus or outside the campus – ***Hostlers are not allowed to drive any powered vehicle please see hostel security rules.***

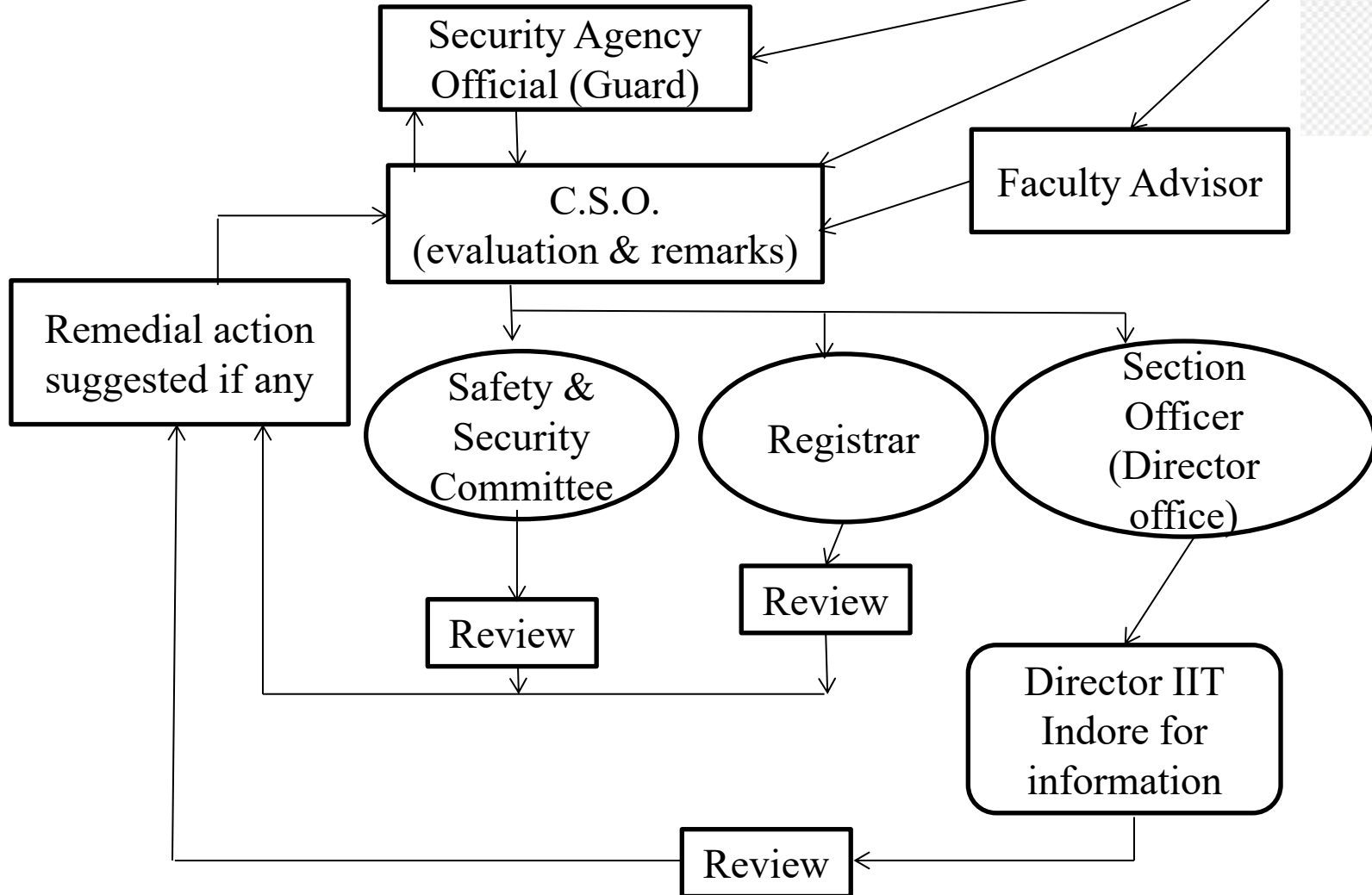

Remember,

- Control your sentiments
- Do not move towards forest area (only planned visits are allowed)
- Do not go to the under-construction buildings.
- Do not go to the road behind the health center (just adjacent to the forest area).
- Do not go to terrace of any building.
- Do not go to the Electrical Substations and Water tanks.
- Do not go to the HVAC tunnel
- Avoid walking in the unmanned area
- Avoid moving out of your residence alone especially during the night time
 - Specific permission is required for moving out of hostel after 10 pm
 - Specific permission is required for moving out of campus after 10 pm
- Use shoes while you are out of your room to avoid snake bite.
- Work in laboratory when your colleagues are present.
- Always keep the emergency contact numbers handy.
- Inform the Emergency Control Room in case you notice anything unusual.
