We are happy to share the photo of two wheeler parking used by the faculty and staff members coming to the Abhinandan Bhawan. We are grateful and acknowledge the noble gesture of all the 2 wheeler users who have played a role model for all of us. The photo of the parking is attached for your reference. Thank you for making the place neat and worthy to be seen and boasted for the same.

We look forward similar response from all the community members for parking and traffic safety on campus. Let all of us make the campus road more safe and use worthy by all.

Following traffic safety is being advised: -

1. Please drive slow on the campus road the speed limit on the campus road is 30 km per hour.
2. Two crowded places have been noticed and the maximum speed at the two places viz. T-point at shopping lane, and the curve near the Jucilicious Cafe has been reduced to 10 km per hour, please take care as many community members cross at these two points.
3. Please take a turn only through your own driving lane, and avoid right turn via the shortest route (it may lead to head on collision).

Of late, it has been observed that vehicles and bicycles are being parked in the following NO PARKING zones:-

- i) on the turn at the road in front of the Jucilicious.
- ii) on the road opposite to the newly upcoming food joints on the road leading to the hostels from the LRC side.

Parking on these roads not only creates inconvenience for the community members passing by, but also poses a risk for road accidents in the area. Due NO Parking, boards have been placed on the poles and road on in the areas. It is therefore requested **NOT TO PARK** the vehicles and bicycles on the roads.

Parking for the T-point eateries can be done on the road behind the Learning Resource Center (please refer to the photo attached). Apart from this a parking is coming up just next to the three outlets, till time the vehicles and bicycles can be parked beyond two poles on the road leaving spaces for other vehicles.

It is further noticed that the bicycles are parked **just next to the barricades placed on the road leading to the swimming pool and indoor games arena**. These bicycles give the place a shabby look and it becomes very difficult for the emergency vehicle like Ambulance, QRT to reach the places in case of any emergency. Hence the bicycles and two wheelers are required to be parked in the parking space available just next to the road. four wheelers may be parked in parking available on the corner of the outdoor sports ground. It will hardly take another minute to park the vehicles and bicycles at proper places.

Let us make our campus more appealing to others while they see our parking lots and roads. Our small efforts will definitely make a great difference in the outsider's perception about us.
